











"In the current debate on justice in immigration, a central issue is whether and, if so, on what conditions, immigrants should be granted a right to stay. In this book, we argue that liberal-democratic receiving states should also grant migrants a right not to stay. [...] Our focus on the right not to stay is prompted instead by the realization that increasing numbers of migrants throughout the world conceive and plan their migratory experience as limited in time and instrumental to goals and projects that they will pursue once back in their country of origin. We call these migratory plans, which are aimed at return, temporary migration projects. [...] In our discussion of temporary migration, we adopt a migrant-centred point of view. [...] Our reason for adopting this specific point of view, which places migrants' projects at the centre of the normative theory of migration, is the endorsement of the quintessentially liberal principle that in the end what matters, in assessing institutional arrangements, is their impact on individual lives. Moreover, in line with this approach, we assume that individual lives should not be seen as mere aggregates of needs and interests, but should be identified instead with the existential projects, the plans and the distinctive ways by which each person decides to lead their existence. The fundamental idea we rely on is that people have a right to pursue their happiness according to their own lights, and institutions should be built in a way that makes such a pursuit possible".
