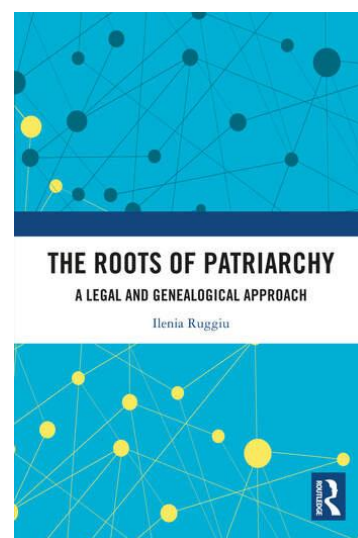

“This book investigates the roots of patriarchy in Western thought and social life. In a context in which the concept has returned to the public debate and has begun to be used again by activists (e.g., the #MeToo movement) and politicians, I felt the need to better understand this key feminist concept. [...] With my background as a constitutional lawyer, I see this concept as crucial to understanding constitutional dynamics. I see patriarchy as a parallel constitutional order, one that constitutionalists call ‘the material constitution’, to distinguish it from the formal one. [...] The genealogy of the concept is based on authors mainly from the Western world, and the events described are those of Western history. Nevertheless, the dynamic here described, particularly the depatriarchalization processes that have occurred in Western legal systems, could be useful to understand how patriarchy works also in other existing gender regimes”.
