

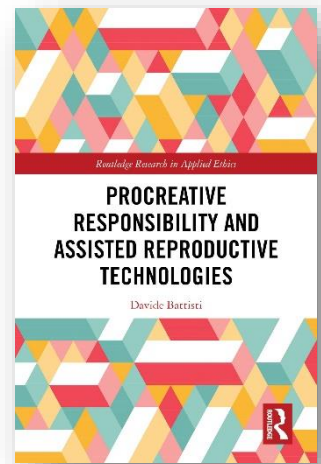

“[...] Human beings have always sought information on human reproduction and, therefore, attempted to influence it. [...] Assisted Reproductive Technologies (ARTs) are commonly considered tools that extend prospective parents’ control over certain aspects of procreation and, consequently, their ability to determine progeny, increasing their procreative freedom. [...] These [...] reproductive technologies have the potential to radically transform our understanding of parenthood and our relationship with progeny. [...] this book aims to rethink the concept of procreative responsibility in light of the continuous development of ARTs, investigating the moral obligations of those who are about to procreate. To do this, I will propose a reflection within the person-affecting morality, according to which, roughly speaking, what matters morally is not producing a state of affairs with greater well-being, but the actions and omissions that can affect or at least be directed at actual people. [...] Based on the technical and conceptual considerations, I will analyze the arguments proposed in the literature to assess whether there is an actual extension of procreative responsibility in light of new technological possibilities at the beginning of life and, from this, provide an original proposal”.
