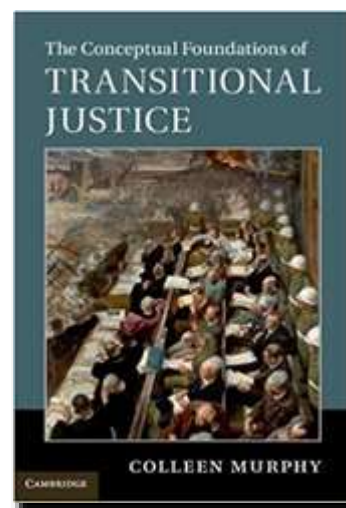

“In recent decades, dozens of countries emerging from long periods of repressive rule and civil conflict have attempted the difficult transition to democracy. [...] The term *transitional justice* is generally taken to refer to formal attempts by postrepressive or postconflict societies to address past wrongdoing in their efforts to democratize. [...] My interest is in the moral evaluation of the choices transitional communities make in dealing with wrongdoing. [...] The overarching objective of this book is articulating what transitional justice demands. My analysis aims to provide philosophers, lawyers, [...] as well as policy makers and citizens of transitional communities, with the conceptual tools to morally evaluate options for dealing with and decisions about legacies of violence and wrongdoing.
