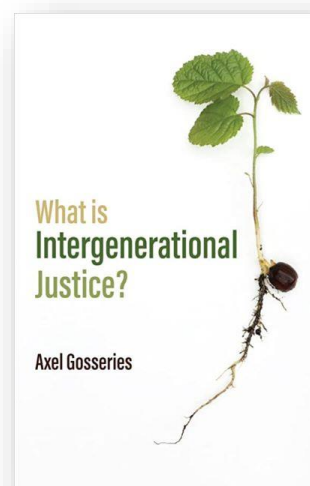

“Hence, this book on generations and justice is intended for philosophers and non-philosophers alike. It builds on work by philosophers over the last decades. It focuses on the present and the future, less on our relationship with the past. It will not discuss measurement methods or alternative indicators to gross domestic product (GDP). Nor will it provide up-to-date figures about whether the next generations can be expected to be worse off than us or whether some generations among us have been sacrificed. Yet it bears on these questions in important ways. It will explore whether what we owe the future is a matter of justice at all. It will discuss whether justice requires that the next generations be better off than us. It will look into how to assess whether a generation is doing better than another. It will touch on how institutional design may contribute to intergenerational fairness”. (from *Introduction*, p. 2)
