

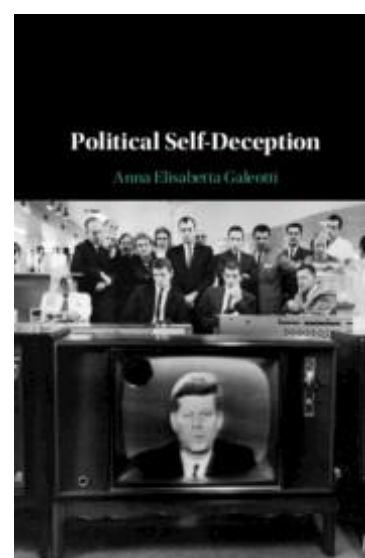

“The aim of this work is to contribute to the study and, possibly, the treatment of political deception. (...) Political deception is generally acknowledged as a relevant, if problematic, issue for democratic politics. (...) This work aims at sidestepping the fork between pure dishonesty and cynicism, on the one hand, and honest mistakes, on the other. (...) [In this work] I argue in favor of taking SD seriously in politics. Several considerations suggest that SD is not only present but also plays an important role in the realm of democratic politics. Among them, SD may present both an explanatory and a normative advantage for making sense of certain political decisions that bring about bad outcomes. (...) The reconstruction of the people's SD is crucial for the normative theory of democracy. That people can be self-deceived about the political reality, the available options (...).”
