

L'integrazione euro-mediterranea dopo gli accordi di prossimità

Abstract: The article focuses on the establishment of a Euro-Mediterranean Free Trade Area in 2010 and its relation with the 2004-2007 enlargements of the European Union. An analysis of the liberalization of the Euro-Mediterranean trade and its impact on the South-Eastern Mediterranean Countries is presented, followed by a comparative assessment of the economic integration and catch up movement of the Central-Eastern European and South-Eastern Mediterranean Countries towards the EU-15. The EU's offer of regional integration is finally reviewed with respect to the features of the European Neighbourhood Policy and of the Mediterranean Union, with the purpose of evaluating the EU Mediterranean economic policy and its potential for the South-Eastern Mediterranean Countries.
