Disagreement about Justice and Liberal Legitimacy: Is there a Place for Political Toleration?

Abstract: Is it possible to locate a conceptual and normative space for an idea of political toleration compatible with the neutrality of the state? Many liberal theorists consider this task impossible. Contrary to this view, I suggest looking at disagreements about justice as the key to overcome this seeming impossibility. I argue that we have political toleration when someone refrains from a *legitimate* interference with what one disapproves of. At the same time, in liberal societies, we can appropriately refer to political toleration only when there is a conflict between political values that challenges the legitimacy of such an interference. Against this background, my aim is twofold: to counteract the reduction of the concept of toleration to other political ideas and to give an account of the normative usefulness of this concept within a neutralist liberal political theory.
