Discussing the Relationship between Law, Science, and Technology

Abstract: The absence of a shared approach among science, technology, law and consumers on GMOs, leads us to reflect on the real utility of their use in agriculture. International, European and national institutions reaffirm the central role of the precautionary principle, not only in the presence of a risk to the environment, but as a general principle for the protection of interests other than economic factors. The proposal is to retrieve a model of economic development not based on homologated productions connected to an intensive agriculture, but oriented to the enhancement of regional identities.
