The Unbearable Heaviness of the Physiological Corruption

Abstract: A common opinion, on which converge both theoretical reflections based on venerable sociological theories, as spontaneous conceptions expressed by social actors, takes for granted a certain physiological dose of corruption in the existing social systems. The corruption seems, however, the result of a instrumental rationality, functional to a social organization that favors selfish behavior at the expense of reciprocity. A State interested to fight corruption, should therefore commit themselves to form a citizen capable of combining politic knowledge with the ethical need of mutual aid.
