*Eugenio Lecaldano and the Search for the Meaning of life*

*Abstract:* Eugenio Lecaldano's last book about the meaning of life is quite insightful on many issues and completes his views on moral philosophy. My critical attention is focused on whether the search for the meaning of life is a "social and public" issue or a "personal and private" one; and on the relationships that the search for the meaning of life has with morality. On both topics Lecaldano seems to hold different positions, even though the prevalent one is that the private perspective of the search for meaning should come first than morality. The opposite view is hinted.
