Embedded Liberalism under the Test of War and Inflation

Abstract: Because of the war in Ukraine and the resurgence of inflation, in recent months the chances that a new form of “inclusive liberalism” takes over and opens a new phase of capitalism in advanced liberal democracies have declined. Still, does this mean that our corner of the world is condemned to a Gramscian interregnum where “the old is dying and the new cannot be borne”? Not necessarily so. In the article, the author discusses whether the conditions to move to a more stable and inclusive form of capitalism can still be fulfilled despite an international and domestic environment decisively more difficult and complicated than just one year ago.
